

### Club Info

Wilmington Country Club was founded in 1901 and is set among the rolling hills of the Delaware Valley, surrounded by land formerly owned by the renowned duPont family. The club is a 36-hole private, member-owned facility with approximately 775 families. The club has a long history of supporting amateur golf and is hosting the 2022 BMW Championship, part of the FedEx Cup Playoffs. Wilmington's South & North Courses have hosted numerous national, regional, and local championships including six USGA Championships:

The South Course is the #1 golf course in the state of Delaware and has been recognized in Golf Digest's Top 100. Over the past 25 years the club has invested more than \$50 million in capital improvements and enhancements without special assessment. In addition to two golf courses, golf facilities include a short game practice range, dedicated wedge range, seven practice putting greens, an indoor/outdoor teaching building with three hitting bays, double ended practice range, and Trackman Golf Simulator Indoor Studio in the Clubhouse.
