FACILITY DESCRIPTION

The Aspetuck Valley Country Club is a private member-owned facility perpetuated solely for the enjoyment of its members and their guests. AVCC has been a family-oriented facility from its outset and has always offered outstanding service and programming. The Club is located in the Metropolitan PGA Section of Fairfield County, approximately 45 miles north of New York City. Founded in 1967, its facilities include an 18-hole Hal Purdy designed golf course, court tennis, platform tennis, swimming pool, seasonal indoor golf simulator and clubhouse.

The Aspetuck Valley Country Club has an active golfing membership with over 300 members whom play approximately 15,000 rounds annually. Yearly golf activities include member tournaments, Monday outings, summer camps, clinics and private golf instruction.

JOB DESCRIPTION

General Responsibilities: The Entry Level Assistant Golf Professional will be a 6/7-month seasonal position from approximately mid-April through mid-October (flexible). The individual will assist with the management of the daily golf operation including golf shop inventory management, tournament programming, minor club repair and junior golf instruction. The candidate will also work closely with the Manager of Golf Services to help oversee all outside golf operations including bag room, golf car and practice facility management. Experience in golf shop operations, merchandising, junior golf programs, and tournament operations are important. This person will be an active ambassador for an exceptional golf experience and be expected to play with member groups as their schedule permits.

SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES

- Assist the fellow Assistant Golf Professionals with men's, women's and junior golf events and programming including planning, pre-tournament operations, post tournament billing, promotion, basic course set up, preparation, scoring, prize distribution, and follow up.
- Control golf shop inventory including all hard and soft good merchandise. Manage special orders, initial and receiving procedures, inputting into point of sale program, pricing procedures, display and sales.
- Maintain an attractive and orderly appearance in and around the golf shop.
- Assist with golf shop opening and closing procedures.
- Provide minor golf club repair
- Work with the fellow Assistant Golf Professionals to ensure that lesson bags are staged prior to members arriving for their appointment.

- The successful candidate must be outgoing, energetic, youthful, very visible, easily approachable, pro-

active in nature, and possess a strong desire to learn the skills necessary to become a Head Golf Professional.
