SURVEY SUMMARY

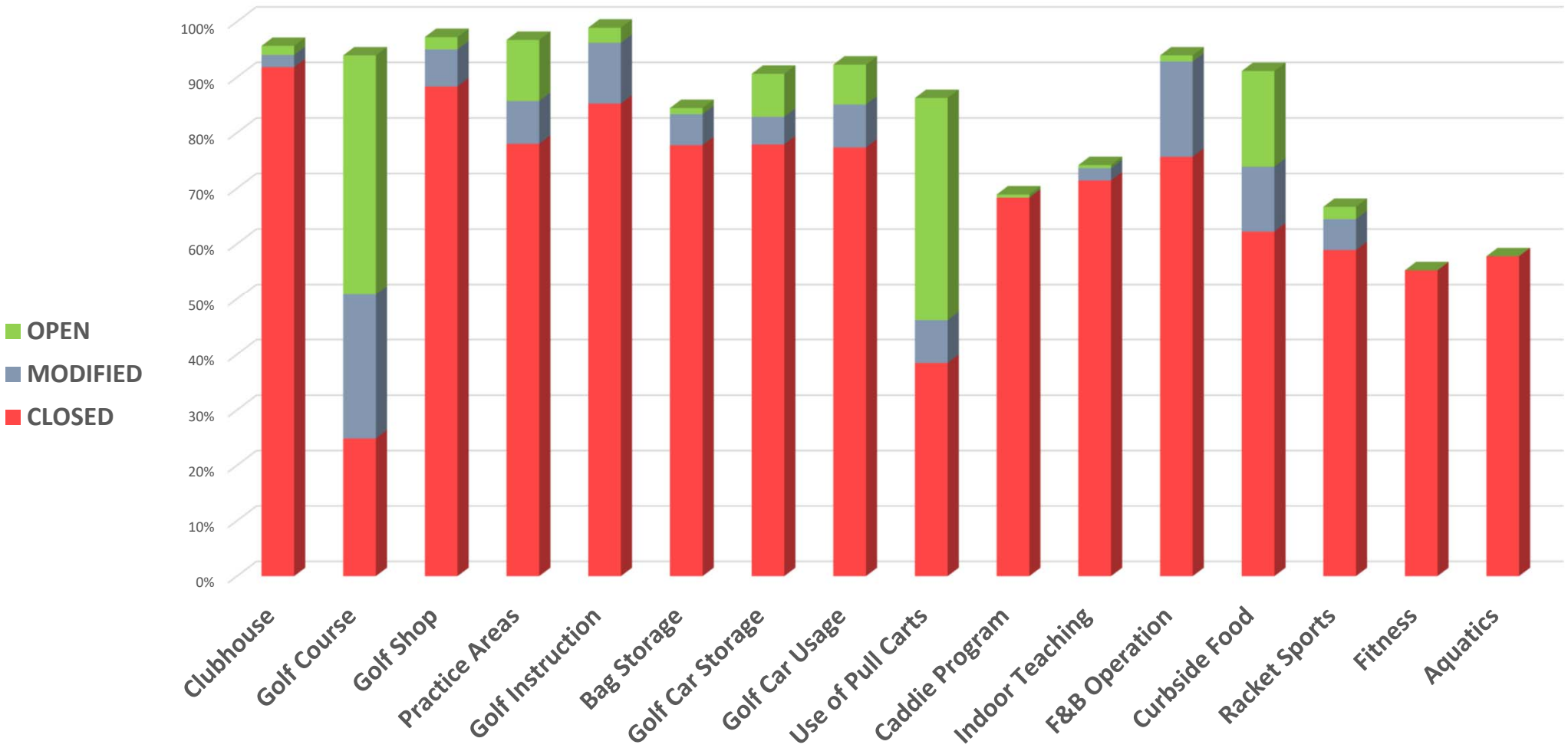


There were **183** responses

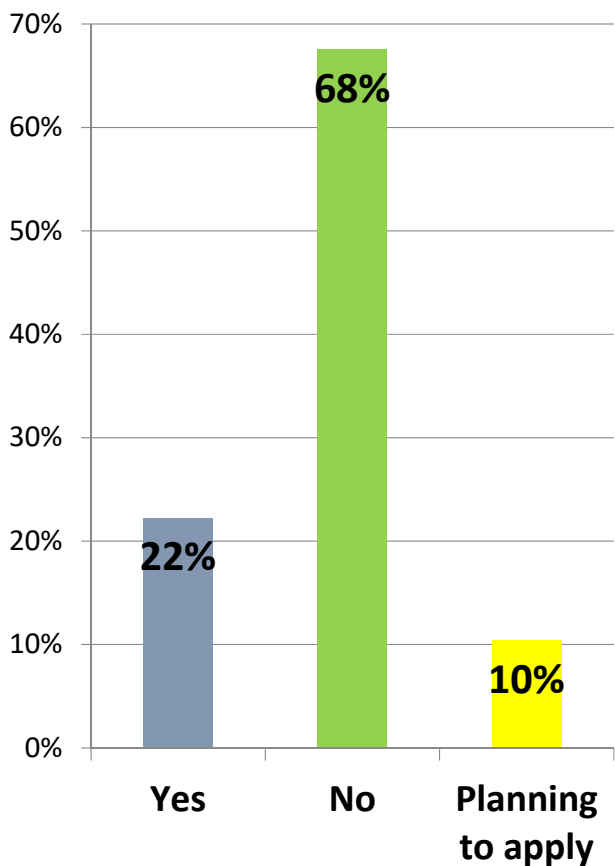
Of which...

- 62% were A-1 & A-4
- 21% were A-8
- 17% were all other classifications
- 76% of professionals and their staff are **not** required to go to work while 24% are currently required
- 86% have made changes or are in the process of changing their 2020 Budget
- 64% know someone who has Covid-19

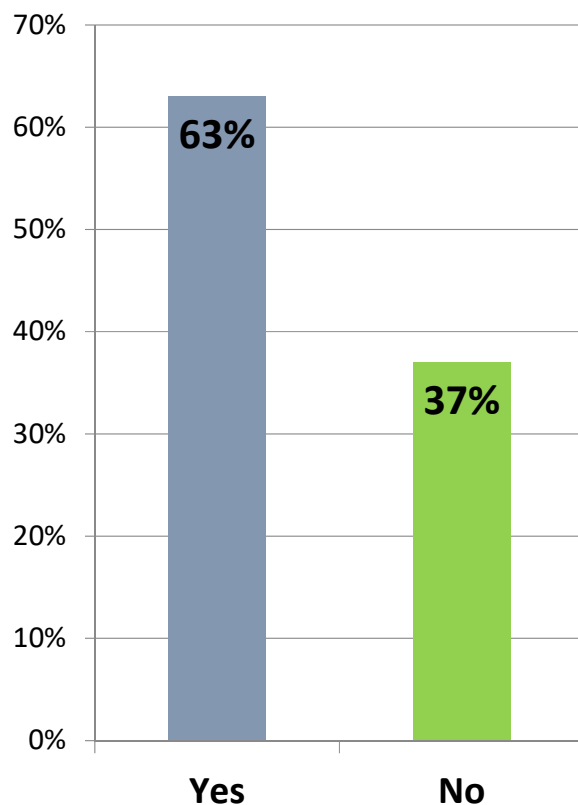
CURRENT STATUS OF CLUB OPERATIONS



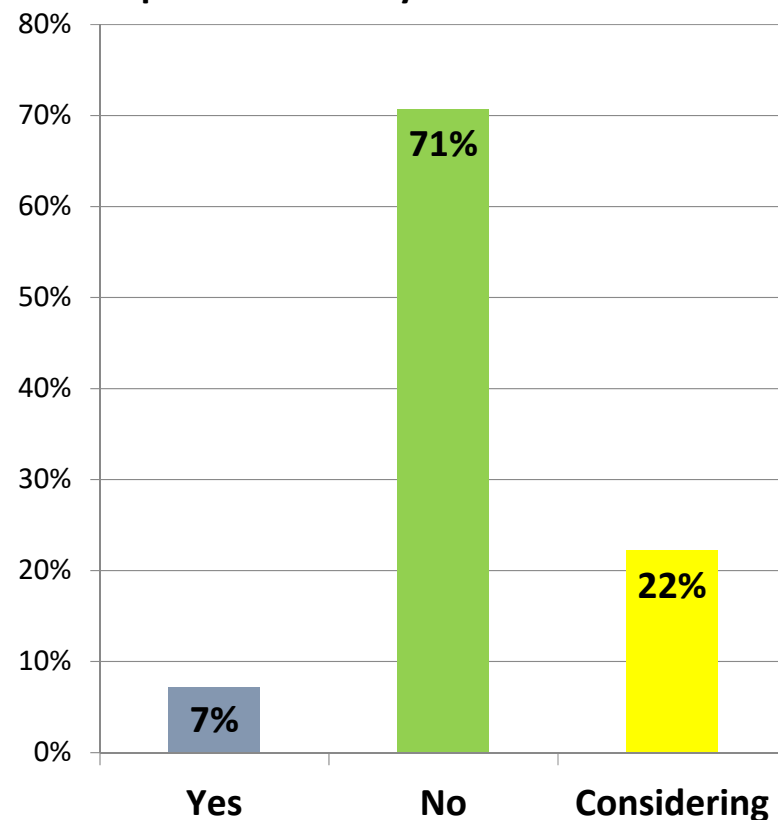
Have you filed for Unemployment?



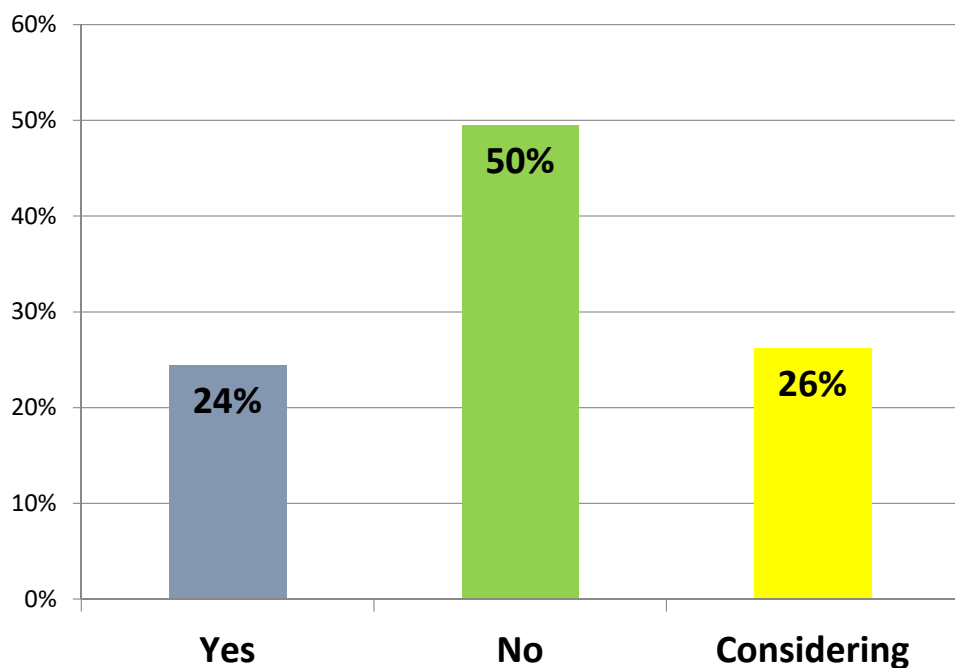
Are you currently being paid by your club during this Stay at Home order?



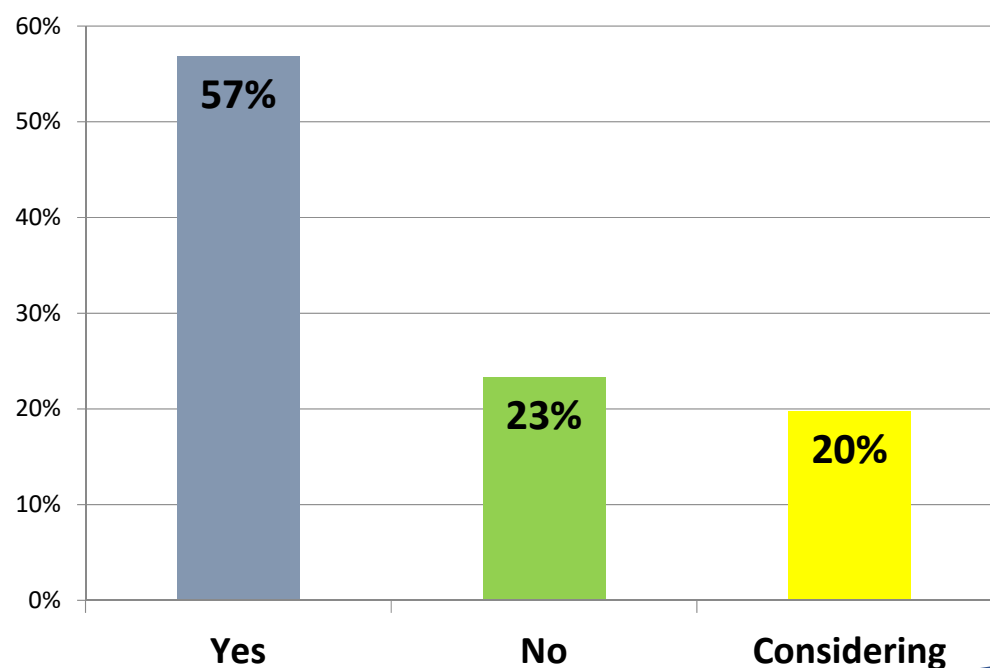
Are the sports professionals being compensated for any lost lesson revenue?

What COVID-19 measures has your club taken at the golf course and practice facilities?

- Removal of: rakes, ball washers, benches, watercoolers, garbage cans, seed bottles
- No communal tees, ball markers, divot tools, scorecards, pencils
- One rider per cart, carts sanitized after play
- No bathrooms or access to clubhouse
- No physical contact with anyone's equipment
- Walking only, no bag storage available
- Longer tee time intervals, limits on groups
- Players must stay in car until tee time
- Cups: Noodles in the cups, raised cups, turned the cups upside down
- Plexi set up at counter to prevent exchanges. Limited cash exchange
- A majority of clubs have suspended their guest policy
- Lifted ban on pull carts
- Mobile golf shop established, online golf lessons
- Reduced maintenance staff
- A majority of practice areas are closed
