About The Club

In 1965, three local businessmen and good friends, Louis Nazzaro, Russ DiFranco and Nick Nerich, shared a dream: to create "a place of complete enjoyment and relaxation for you and your children, and a place where you will be proud to entertain your guests." Their vision of a "little club in the country" began to take shape in 1966 when they purchased the Costello farm and created the Redding Country Club Holding Corporation. As the club membership grew throughout the 70s, RCC hired golf architect Rees Jones, son of legendary golf course designer Robert Trent Jones, to transform the original 9 holes into a unique and challenging 18-hole layout. Taking advantage of the natural streams and ponds, Jones incorporated precipitous elevation changes to carve out a 6277-yard course that proves the adage, "Don't judge a course by its length." Redding hosts numerous Metropolitan PGA, MGA, WGA, and CSGA events each season.

Position Overview
