Our Golf Course opened for play in 1901 as a nine-hole layout and was expanded to eighteen holes by Tom Bendelow in 1921. A 1938 hurricane decimated Long Island and reduced the course to its current nine-hole form. The club is enjoyed by a global, golf-savvy membership who call Quogue their summer home. A quiet spring will give way to a busy summer with a tournament calendar featuring 36 golf events for Men, Ladies, and Juniors and a Junior Golf program running five days each week.
